COMMENTS: Unidentified data entry errors account for the 6 animal difference in the shelter count. \* NHS takes in all owner surrendered pets but does not provide owner requested euthanasia as a service. Instead, our veterinary team makes the decision on treatability. However in 2014 we did provide end of life services for some of our adopted "Angel Pets". The Angel Pet program was developed for animals who were difficult to find homes for due to a chronic medical condition but who still enjoyed a good quality of life. NHS provides post adoption medical care for these pets, many times for the duration of their life. (135 pets placed into homes 2014 thru the Angel Pet program)
