



Nevada Humane Society's Donor-Subsidized Spay/Neuter Program

Nevada Humane Society's low-cost Spay/Neuter clinic is subsidized by donations and is available for low-income residents of Northern Nevada. To make a donation in support of our Spay/Neuter services, please visit www.NevadaHumaneSociety.org. Our low-cost services are reserved for cats and dogs. All dogs and cats over the age of 8 must have pre-op bloodwork performed prior to the appointment, therefore by another veterinarian.

Appointments are limited and in high demand. *If you are not in need of financial assistance we encourage you to use your own veterinarian.* We strongly recommend that all pet owners establish a relationship with a local, full-service veterinary hospital to provide for the pet's health throughout its lifetime.

For Washoe County residents (2825 Longley Lane in Reno):

Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) for feral cats are held Wednesdays and Sundays. Drop off is 7am to 8:30am. Feral cats must be three months old or at least 3lbs in weight. Cats must be in a humane trap and accompanied with a plastic carrier in good repair to go home in. All cats are spayed/neutered, vaccinated and eartipped. The Spay/Neuter clinic operates Monday through Friday, excluding some holidays. To schedule an appointment, please call **775-856-2000 ext. 333**.

For Carson City residents (549 Airport Road in Carson City):

Low-cost Spay/Neuter is available for those who cannot otherwise afford it. People must qualify by showing proof of social security or public assistance. Low-cost vaccines and microchips are also available. The Carson City clinic hours will be as follows for those that qualify:

- Monday and Thursday, by appointment only, spay and neuter services for dogs
- Friday, by appointment only, spay and neuter services for cats
- Free Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) for feral (wild) cats is available every Tuesday and walk-ins are welcome (no appointment needed). Other details include:
 - Cats must arrive in humane traps (no boxes, crates or pet carriers)
 - Loaner traps available with refundable deposit
 - Kittens must be a minimum of 3lbs or 3 months old
 - All cats and kittens will be spayed or neutered, vaccinated and eartipped
- **A low-cost, walk-in based vaccine clinic** will be held every Friday, beginning August 18, from 3pm to 5pm for dogs and cats in Carson City.
