Dogs, cats and small animals for adoption will be available from Nevada Humane Society, SPCA of Northern Nevada, Pet Network Humane Society, Canine Rehabilitation Center & Sanctuary (CRCS) and other smaller rescue groups. In addition, Washoe County Regional Animal Services will be offering free microchips for all pets in attendance! *Nevada's Super Pet Adoption Day is Saturday, October 14 at Rancho San Rafael Park from 10am to 4pm.*

“Coming together as a team and hosting a community adoption event is something we know works for each one of our local shelters.
