Low-Cost Spay/Neuter Surgeries for Personal Pet Cats and Dogs in Zip Code 89433 and 89431

Sponsored by PetSmart Charities®

Thanks to funding provided by PetSmart Charities®, more low-cost spay and neuter services are now available at Nevada Humane Society for some specific four-legged residents. The campaign begins February 1, 2018 and runs through the end of the year, with a goal to spay and neuter over 750 pets who reside in zip codes 89433 and 89431.

Cats may be spayed or neutered for \$10. Dogs must be either a Chihuahua or a Pit Bull and may be spayed or neutered for \$20. Both cats and dogs will also receive free vaccines at the time of service. All services are appointment only, and spaces are limited as a first-come, first-served basis. Appointments may be made by contacting Nevada Humane Society at 775-856-2000 ext. 333.

“Research shows us that the largest number of unaltered pets, especially for Chihuahuas and Pit Bulls, reside in these two zip codes, which is why PetSmart Charities targeted this area,” said Kimberly Wade, Communications Director for Nevada Humane Society. “We know that by altering these animals, we can make a big impact on our population of unwanted dogs and puppies. It’s pretty simple. If we can prevent future animal intake today—we save lives tomorrow.”

Pet parents who wish to take advantage of this offer must make an appointment by calling 775-856-2000 ext. 333. Appointments are for specific pets only:

- **Cats in 89433 and 89431**
- **Chihuahuas and Pit Bulls in 89433 and 89431**

Calls may take up to 48 hours to be returned due to call volume, and appointment spaces are limited.
