Adopt a Less-Adoptable Yet Still Lovable Pet Today! May 10-28 at Nevada Humane Society

Although many pets reside at Nevada Humane Society for only a short time, some of our furry friends have a harder time finding their home. Some are shy or extremely energetic, others older, some are a bit sassy, and a few have special needs. These pets may be considered to be less-adoptable, but they are still lovable, and they need your help—they're seeking a family just like yours! Choose from someone more mature, or maybe someone with a special need who needs a bit more love than normal. Looking to keep the family small? There are several dogs and cats who prefer to be your only child, so no need to share the love with other human or animal siblings.

The less-adoptable yet still lovable campaign was designed to draw attention to special animals that tend to stay at the shelter longer simply because of their age, personality, or medical condition. It runs May 10 through May 28, and adoption fees are as follows:

- Adult dogs: \$50
- Adult cats over the age of five: Free
- Adult cats under the age of five: \$25
- Kittens: \$60

All dogs and cats are spayed and neutered, vaccinated, and microchipped before being adopted. Rabbits are also spayed or neutered. These services would normally cost over \$250.

Nevada Humane Society is open for adoptions seven days a week at two locations from 11am to 6:30pm and an hour earlier at 10am on Saturday. For pet adoptions in Reno, visit 2825 Longley Lane. For pet adoptions in Carson City, visit 549 Airport Road.
