1. Dogs older than 8 years must have pre-op blood work done at a private vet prior to appointment to ensure dog is healthy enough. Owner must bring blood work results to appointment.
2. Vaccination prices below are only for vaccines administered with spay/neuter.
3. Hernia repair only if reducible. Cats \$15 Dogs \$30.
4. Surgery fee includes e-collar for dogs.
5. We do not spay/neuter dogs over 100 lbs.
