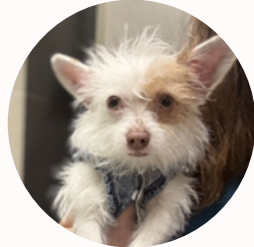
From Crisis to Care
